



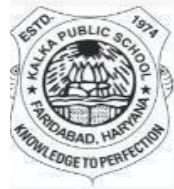

## OVERVIEW OF THE EXAMINATION PATTERN

The academic year is divided into two terms (Term 1 & Term 2) to ensure continuous assessment, including periodic tests, practicals, and final exams.

- Internals (20 Marks) include Unit Tests, Practical Exams, Project Work, Notebook Submission, and Subject Enrichment Activities.
- Final Exam/Board Exam covers the entire syllabus and contributes the major weightage.

### Key Points:

- ✓ Both Terms Contribute to Final Assessment – Performance in Term 1 and Term 2 is considered for the final grade.
- ✓ Internals Play a Crucial Role – Practical subjects like Science, Computer, and Commerce include practical exams and viva assessments.
- ✓ Passing Criteria: Students must score at least 33% in each subject (theory + internals combined).

# **Overview of the Examination Pattern**

## **PARAMETERS**

### **1. Scholastic Parameters (Academic Performance)**

- **Periodic Tests (PTs):** Short assessments conducted periodically to test specific syllabus portions.
- **Mid-Term Exam:** Covers approximately 50% of the syllabus and helps in assessing mid-year progress.
- **Pre-Annual/Pre-Board Exam:** Conducted before final exams to prepare students for comprehensive assessments.
- **Final Exam/Board Exam:** Full syllabus examination, determining promotion (IX & XI) or certification (X & XII).
- **Internal Assessment:** Includes projects, practicals, assignments, and subject enrichment activities.
- **Attendance & Eligibility:** Minimum 75% attendance is required to appear for the final/board exam.

### **2. Internal Assessment Parameters (20 Marks)**

- **Periodic Tests:** Short-term assessments contributing to academic performance.
- **Notebook Submission:** Evaluated based on regularity, organization, and completeness.
- **Subject Enrichment Activities:** Includes practical's, oral tests, projects, and creative assignments.
- **Practical Work (For Applicable Subjects):** Includes laboratory experiments, viva, and practical file submission.

### **3. Co-Scholastic Parameters (Holistic Development)**

- **Work Education:** Focuses on vocational skills and productivity-based learning.
- **Art Education:** Includes creative subjects like drawing, music, dance, and theatre.
- **Health & Physical Education:** Involves sports, yoga, and other fitness-related activities.
- **Discipline & Values:** Assessed through behaviour, punctuality, class participation, and ethics.

### **4. Attendance & Promotion Criteria**

- **Minimum Attendance:** 75% attendance is mandatory to qualify for the final exams.
- **Promotion in IX & XI:** Determined by performance in term exams and overall internal assessment.
- **Board Exam Eligibility (X & XII):** Requires fulfilment of attendance, internal assessments, and CBSE guidelines.

## Co-Scholastic Activities (For Classes IX-XII)

For the holistic development of the students, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out by the teachers and will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale: -

c) **Personal Hygiene**-The students will be assessed for personal hygiene. They should bathe every day, wear a washed, ironed school uniform, have properly trimmed nails, hair should be cut and properly combed and shoes should be polished.

d) **Punctuality** –The student will be assessed for being punctual to school.

e) **Initiative**-The student will be assessed for active participation in various school programs and class activities.

f) **Height (in cms) /Weight (in kgs).**
