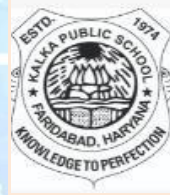

PARAMETERS
(For classes I-II)

a) Oral Skills:

These are subjects specific to be carried out throughout the term by the respective teachers. However, these should be evaluated for each assessment.

For Languages (English/Hindi): Reading, Recitation and Dictation to be conducted. For Mathematics / EVS : Orals to be conducted for each assessments.

b) Notebook Submission:

Notebook submission is aimed at evaluating and enhancing seriousness of students towards writing on the topics being taught in the classroom as well as assignments. This will also address the critical aspects of regularity, punctuality, neatness and upkeep of notebook.

c) Subject Enrichment Activities:

These are subject specific activities aimed at evaluating and enhancing the understanding and skills of the students. These activities are to be carried out throughout the term by the respective teachers. However, these should be evaluated for each assessment.

- For Languages: Aimed at equipping the learner to develop effective listening and speaking skills - reading, recitation, role play etc.
- For Mathematics: Mental Math or Project work can be undertaken.
- For EVS: Projects, Activities and Experiments.

d) **Computer:** 15 [written] + 5 marks [practical] = 25 marks for each assessment.

e) **GK:** 25 marks paper for each assessment.

f) **Cumulative:** $A1 + A2 + A3 + A4 / 2 = 200 / 2 = 100$ for each subject.

g) **Aggregate** = Cumulative / 400 (Ans. To be rounded off)

Co-Scholastic Activities (For Classes I-II)

For the holistic development of the students, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out by the teachers and will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale:-

A=Outstanding B=Very Good C=Fair

- a) Discipline:- The students will be assessed for discipline which will be based on the factors like sincerity, punctuality, initiative, behavior, values, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards teachers, colleagues and society, nation and others.
- b) Personal Hygiene-The students will be assessed for personal hygiene. They should bathe everyday, wear a washed, ironed school uniform, have properly trimmed nails, hair should be cut and properly combed and shoes should be polished.
- c) Height (in cms)/Weight (in kgs).
