Term-I Examination (Nov-Dec 2021)

- Question Paper Format- <u>Multiple Choice Questions</u> MCQ including casebased / assertion – reasoning type.
- Duration of Test 90 Minutes
- Syllabus Renationalized syllabus of Term-I only (i.e. approx 50% of the entire syllabus).
- Marks of Term-I Examination will contribute to the final overall score of students.
- The exams will be conducted under the supervision of the External Centre Superintendents and Observers appointed by CBSE.



Term-II Examination (Mar-Apr 2022)

Question Paper Format- <u>questions of differnt formats</u> (case-based /situation-based , open-ended short answer / long answer type) Duration of Test - <u>2 Hours</u>

In case the situation is not conducive for normal descriptive examination a 90 minutes MCQ based exam will be conducted at the end of the Term-II also.



Term-II Examination Contd.. (Mar-Apr 2022)

- Syllabus Renationalized syllabus of Term-II only (i.e. approx 50% of the entire syllabus).
- Marks of Term-II Examination will contribute to the final overall score of students.

The examination would be held at the examination centres fixed by the board



Situation-A

In case the situation of the pandemic improves and students are able to come to school or centres for taking the exam

Board will conduct Term-I and Term-II examinations at schools/centres and the theory marks will be distributed equally between the two exams



Situation-B

In case the situation of the pandemic forces complete closure of schools during November – December 2021, but the Term-II exams are held at schools or centres

Term-I MCQ based examination would be done by the students online/offline from home – in this case, the weightage of this exam for the final score would be reduced and weightage of Term-II exams will be increased for declaration of final result.



Situation-C

In case the situation of the pandemic forces complete closure of schools during March – April 2022 , but the Term-I exams are held at schools or centres

Result would be based on the performance of students on Term-I MCQ based examination and internal assessments. The weightage of marks of Term-I examination conducted by the Board will be increased to provide year-end results of candidates.



Situation-D

In case the situation of the pandemic forces complete closure of schools and Board conducted Term-I and Term-II exams are taken by the candidates from home in the session 2021-22

Result would be computed on the basis of the Internal Assessment / Practical / Project Work and Theory marks of Term-I and Term-II exams taken by the candidate from home in Class X subject to the moderation or other measures to ensure validity and reliability of the assessment.



In all the four situations, data analysis of marks of students will be undertaken to ensure the integrity of Internal Assessments and Home-Based exams.
