Term-I Examination

(Nov-Dec 2021)

Question Paper Format- Multiple Choice Questions MCQ including case-based / assertion – reasoning type.

Duration of Test - 90 Minutes

Syllabus – Renationalized syllabus of Term-I only (i.e. approx 50% of the entire syllabus).

Marks of Term-I Examination will contribute to the final overall score of students.

The exams will be conducted under the supervision of the External Centre Superintendents and Observers appointed by CBSE.



Term-II Examination

(Mar-Apr 2022)

Question Paper Format- questions of different formats

(case-based /situation-based , open-ended short answer / long answer type)

Duration of Test - 2 Hours

In case the situation is not conducive for normal descriptive examination a 90 minutes MCQ based exam will be conducted at the end of the Term-II also.



Term-II Examination Contd..

(Mar-Apr 2022)

Syllabus – Renationalized syllabus of Term-II only (i.e. approx 50% of the entire syllabus).

Marks of Term-II Examination will contribute to the final overall score of students.

The examination would be held at the examination centres fixed by the board



Assessment / Examination as per different situations

Situation-A

In case the situation of the pandemic improves and students are able to come to school or centres for taking the exam

Board will conduct Term-I and Term-II examinations at schools/centres and the theory marks will be distributed equally between the two exams



Assessment / Examination as per different situations

Situation-B

In case the situation of the pandemic forces complete closure of schools during November – December 2021, but the Term-II exams are held at schools or centres

Term-I MCQ based examination would be done by the students online/offline from home – in this case, the weightage of this exam for the final score would be reduced and weightage of Term-II exams will be increased for declaration of final result.



Assessment / Examination as per different situations

Situation-C

In case the situation of the pandemic forces complete closure of schools during March – April 2022 , but the Term-I exams are held at schools or centres

Result would be based on the performance of students on Term-I MCQ based examination and internal assessments. The weightage of marks of Term-I examination conducted by the Board will be increased to provide year-end results of candidates.



Assessment / Examination as per different situations

Situation-D

In case the situation of the pandemic forces complete closure of schools and Board conducted Term-I and Term-II exams are taken by the candidates from home in the session 2021-22

Result would be computed on the basis of the Internal Assessment / Practical / Project Work and Theory marks of Term-I and Term-II exams taken by the candidate from home in Class X subject to the moderation or other measures to ensure validity and reliability of the assessment.



Assessment / Examination as per different situations

In all the four situations, data analysis of marks of students will be undertaken to ensure the integrity of Internal Assessments and Home-Based exams.
